a) Leadership

- Plan physical and virtual library space for HKDSE and IB learners
- Run student librarian club and reading activities

b) Teaching

- Organise workshops on information literacy, including information technology, for junior and senior form students learning to access, evaluate, use, create and communicate information through inquiry and critical thinking
- Teach students how to be good researchers and evaluate information for authority, bias and relevance with academic integrity and honesty in creating and communicating new knowledge
- Implement activities such as book talks, literacy circles, and programs for family participation

c) Information Specialist

- Manage the library system, including e-learning related systems, and develop digital library applications
- Ensure continuous improvement of library programs and services, and keep abreast of professional trends and emerging technologies for potential implementation
