Dear parents, students, alumni and friends,

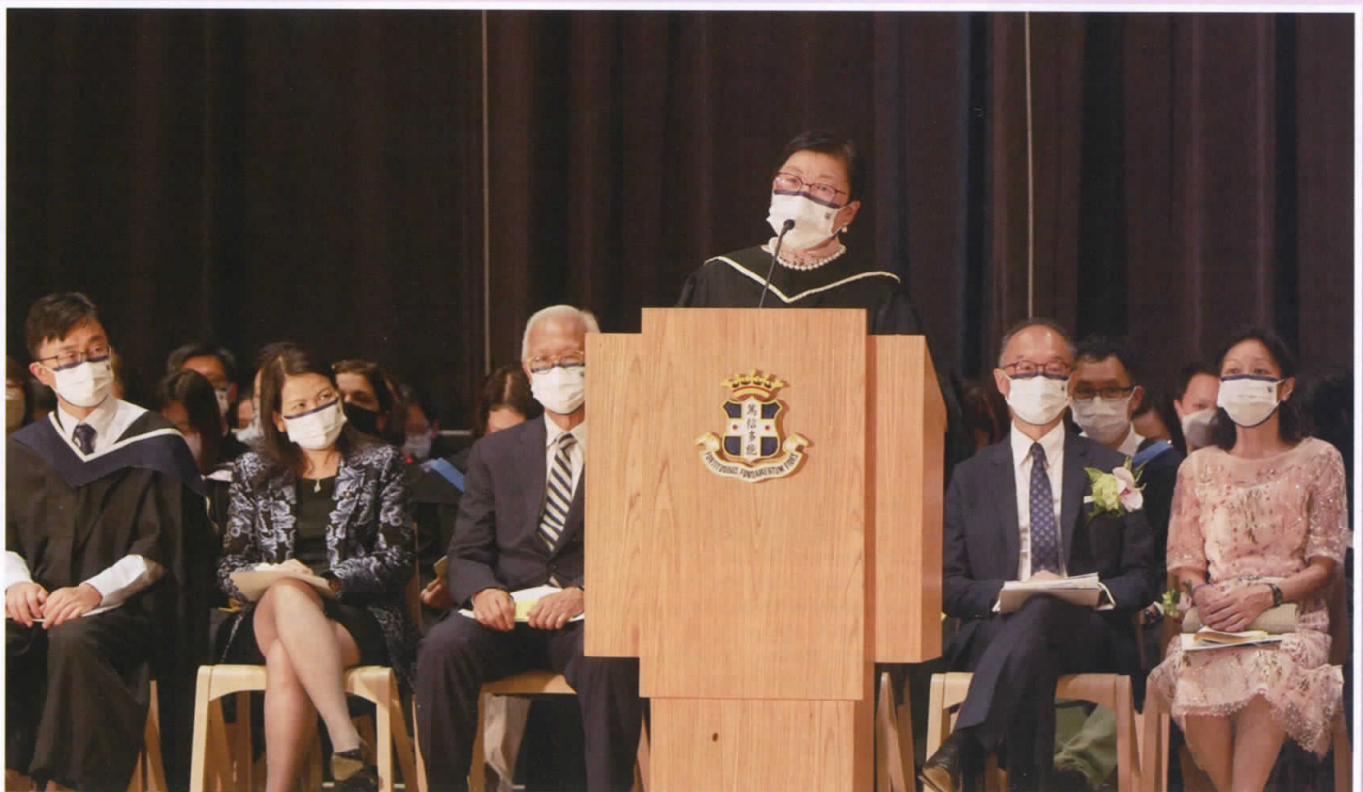

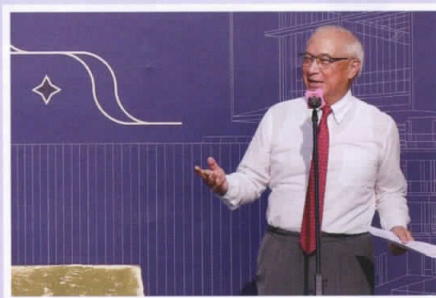

Speech Day and Prize-giving Ceremony: Celebrating Student Success

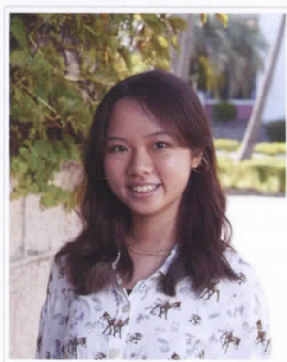

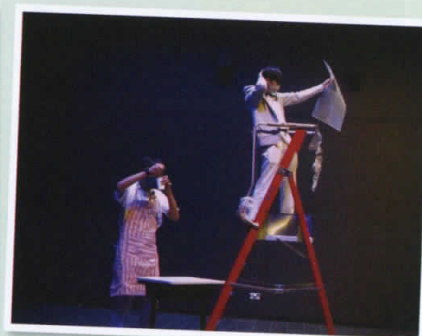

Seminar for S1 Parents and Students on Examination Scope and Skills

A seminar for S1 parents and students on examination scope and skills was held on 5th November, 2022 to help them to prepare for the upcoming First Term Examination. Most students came back to school with their parents to attend the seminar. Teachers explained the assessment policy of St Stephen's College and the exam syllabuses and the skills needed for English, Chinese, Mathematics, Science, Integrated Humanities and Chinese History.



Creativity Programme Harvest Day

The Creativity Programme offers junior form students opportunities to design, engage in and reflect on creative projects that contribute to aesthetic and analytical knowledge creation. Three years of harvest was shared with junior secondary students on 19th October, 2022. Creative works produced by students were on display at Tang Shiu Kin Hall. This was not only an occasion for students to showcase their good work but also a golden opportunity for them to share their experiences and learn from each other.

The three-year programme aims to develop capacities for students to approach challenges or situations in innovative ways and come up with new ideas. In Secondary One, students get a taster of all six programmes, and in Secondary Two and Three, students specialise in one of the six following programmes: 1) Creative Innovation, 2) iEngineering, 3) Creative Business, 4) Creative Media, 5) Creative Ceramics and 6) Creative Music.



S3 Outward Bound Leadership Training Programme (2021-22)

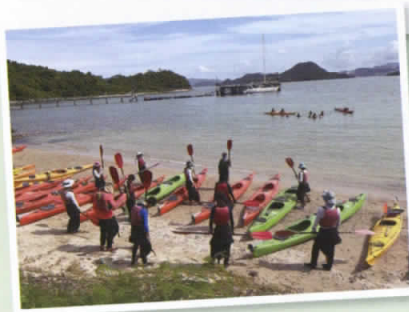
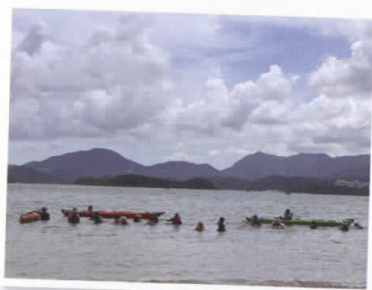
The Outward Bound Leadership Training Programme is a key element of the school curriculum that equips our S3 students with the necessary skills and attitudes to get prepared for the challenges ahead. Owing to the pandemic, however, the programme had been suspended from 2020. Fortunately, we managed to organise one in July 2022, albeit on a smaller scale (for 60 students only).

The Outward Bound course was an invaluable opportunity for S3 students to step out of their comfort zones to try out challenging tasks that we thought were impossible. I found the experience enjoyable and memorable.

One of the highlights was kayaking. During the briefing session, the instructors warned us that we had to kayak a few kilometres a day. I was truly terrified because I had poor physical endurance. This was way beyond my comfort zone. However, without kayaking, we would not be able to arrive at our destinations. Under pressure from my groupmates, I tried it out reluctantly, which turned out to be a serious challenge for me. I sought help from them to learn how to control the vessel. I also persevered and told myself not to give up. Gradually, I made a seemingly impossible mission possible.

This experience in the wilderness greatly broadened my horizons. It made me understand that life is full of unexpected obstacles, but we should always persevere to the very end.

In October and November 2022, our S2 and S3 students took part in a training course on elderly care and a voluntary service experience at a local food bank respectively. These authentic learning experiences can help our students to understand, appreciate and reflect on the adage: 'Giving is better than receiving'.

The opportunity to attend the workshop organised by the Caritas Jockey Club Resource & Support Centre for Carers was a great learning experience for us to understand the meaningful job of a caregiver. It equipped us with the knowledge of how to take care of the elderly and how a small act can make a difference to their lives. We had the opportunity to take turns being an old person: we experienced the struggles they face on a daily basis and the mental and emotional challenges that come with aging. We even had trouble getting in a taxi! Besides, we got to see how hi-tech smart devices can ease their burden and make their lives easier and safer. Most importantly, this workshop taught us that empathy – connecting with people around us with compassion – is the key to a sustainable future.

首先，我們在一個房間裡看了關於Feeding Hong Kong運作方式的視頻。之後，工作人員用心講解他們在疫情下怎麼幫助有需要的市民。他們會把一些包裝「不合格」的產品或是餐廳沒能售出的食品派發給低收入人士。可是，在疫情的經濟不景氣之下，這類型的捐贈越來越少，Feeding Hong Kong甚至額外購入食物來救助他們，減低他們的生計壓力。

接著，我們到了一個小型「流水線」作體驗，為有需要的人士「打包」食物。這一條小小的流水線被工作人員精心劃分為多個部分。為了整個行動能快速和有條不紊地進行，每個人都被分配到不同部分工作，例如：組裝箱子、擺放食用油、擺放大米、最終檢查、封箱……他們先講解要點，然後細心地演示和教導我們處理每個部分，再讓我們著手嘗試。一開始，每個人都顯得信心十足、雄心勃勃，可真正動手處理後，我們就發現每個崗位都不是預期中容易，例如：產品的擺放位置、順序、方向都靠我們摸索及互相配合。運作了一會之後，每個人都變得適應和得心應手起來，工廠裡也播起了音樂，這使我們的工作氛圍輕鬆和愉快。數小時後，每個人都疲憊不堪，甚至漸漸厭倦了這種一成不變的工作，可是，大家本著團隊精神，加上理解到這個工作不僅僅是個班際活動，更是在幫助有需要的人，而且看到徐老師及蘇老師也在與我們一起埋頭苦幹。我們也清楚知道工作人員平日的工作量繁重得多，我們便重拾鬥志，繼續努力完成任務。最後，我們完成了100箱、共400袋的生活必須食品，可以直接贈予不同機構裡有需要的人。最後，我們把拆開了的食品包裝和箱子全部疊好，方便進行回收。

於我而言，這是不可多得的體驗，因為，這次義工經歷不僅加深了我對這類慈善機構的認知和瞭解，也讓我得到莫大的成就感。我明白到豐衣足食的生活是多麼珍貴和值得珍惜。如果大家有多餘的食物，可以捐給Feeding in Hong Kong，救助更多有需要的人！

Geography Society Field Trip to Mil Mill

Mil Mill is the first pulp mill and education centre that recycles beverage cartons in Hong Kong. It processes a maximum of 50 tonnes of beverage cartons daily along with other kinds of waste paper. The paper pulp that is churned out from the plant can then be turned into recycled paper, a more environmentally friendly alternative to virgin paper. Sadly, Mil Mill is now facing eviction as the landlord, Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation, refused to renew the contract. Our Geography Society seized the last opportunity to visit the recycler that has been serving us for three years.

The visit has enriched our knowledge of circular economy, carbon footprint, sustainable forest development, etc. Most importantly, we, as global citizens, have learnt how to engage in sustainable development by identifying and opting for environmentally friendly choices. Besides the presentation and exhibition, we also tried out papermaking with fresh paper pulp and went on a tour of the plant. We are grateful to have had such a precious and fruitful experience and we hope that Mil Mill will find a place to re-establish itself someday.

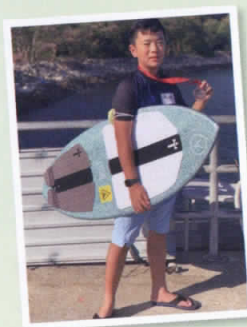

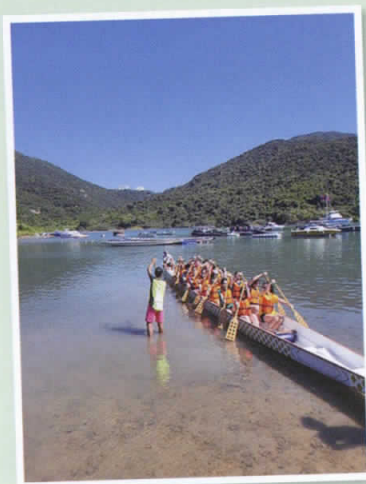
